**RESOLUTION NO. 83 OF 2021 - AUTHORIZING THE FILMING OF THE MOVIE “VIRAL:”**

Attorney Magrino said he will make sure all the insurance is in order. Since the movie will be filming more than 2 consecutive days and more than six days in one calendar year, according to Local Law No. 4 of 2017, a resolution will need to be passed.
