A LOCAL LAW AMENDING § 205-3(6) OF THE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF SUFFERN REGARDING VEHICLE PARKING IN THE VILLAGE OF SUFFERN

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Suffern as follows:

Section 1. Section 205-3(6) of the Code of the Village of Suffern is hereby amended to provide as follows:

It shall be unlawful to park or store or permit to be parked or stored in any yard or open area of a premises any motor vehicle that is abandoned, wrecked, dismantled, junked, substantially damaged or unregistered or which is not intended to be used or in no condition for legal use upon the public highway. No vehicle shall be parked out of doors on any property unless the vehicle license plate is exposed and clearly visible. No vehicle parked or stored out of doors on any property shall be covered with any tarp, material or matter other than a car cover for which the vehicle license plate is exposed and clearly visible.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
